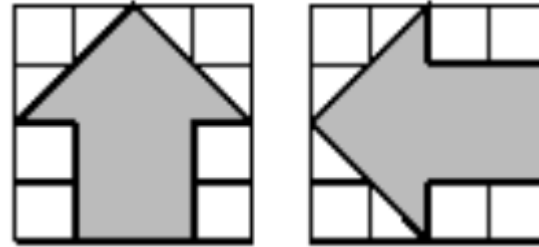


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The diagram shows two arrows drawn on separate 4cm x 4cm grids.
